MRCB Sells Stake in DUKE Highway for RM228 Million Cash

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 29 January 2014 – Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) wishes to announce that it has entered into a sale agreement today with Ekovest Berhad and its subsidiaries for the disposal of MRCB's 30% equity in the Duta-Ulu Kelang Expressway (DUKE).

The sale entails the disposal by MRCB of 1,500,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each and 13,500,000 redeemable preference shares of RM1.00 each in Nuzen, which represent the 30% MRCB stake in the concession highway project.

Nuzen is the joint venture company incorporated on 24 June 1999 between MRCB and Wira Kristal Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Ekovest, based on a shareholding of 30% and 70% respectively. Nuzen is also the holding company of Konsortium Lebuhraya Utara-Timur Sdn Bhd (Kesturi), which is the concession holder of the DUKE.

Thus, the transaction also includes the sale of RM58.5 million Series A redeemable preference shares of RM1.00 each in Kesturi to Ekovest Construction Sdn Bhd (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Ekovest) and another RM54 million in nominal value redeemable secured junior bonds in Kesturi to Ekovest. Altogether the total transaction amounts to a cash consideration of RM228 million.

Commenting on this move by the Group, MRCB's Group Chief Operating Officer, Imran Datuk Mohamad Salim said, "We have monetised a premier infrastructure asset in the Klang Valley, which is part of an overall initiative to align our business direction.

"We believe that the timely sale of our shares in this project bodes well for our strategy to bring gains in other areas of our current set-up, while focusing on the Group's core competencies".

The disposal of its shares in DUKE is part of the MRCB group's strategy to finance working capital and repay part of its borrowings, while bringing focus to its resources on property development and urban regeneration, together with specialised infrastructure and environment projects that MRCB is well-known for.

After careful deliberation, the MRCB Board of Directors, having considered all aspects of the exercise including the rationale and effects of the share sale, is of the opinion that the move is in the best interests of MRCB.

About DUKE

The **DUKE** is an 18-kilometer long expressway toll road which provides connectivity to the East-West route of the Northern part of Kuala Lumpur. It effectively connects the North Klang Valley Expressway ("**NKVE**") on the west side of Kuala Lumpur to the Kuala Lumpur-Karak Highway in the North and the Middle Ring Road 2 in the East.

The DUKE is made up of three essential links – the Duta Link which runs from the NKVE's Projek Lebuhraya Utara-Selatan's ("**PLUS**") Duta Toll plaza and Sri Hartamas towards the East, connecting to main roads such as Jalan Kuching and Jalan Sentul. The Ulu Kelang Link continues eastwards from the Duta Link and crosses radial roads such as Jalan Semarak, Jalan Setiawangsa and Jalan Pahang. The Karak Link provides access to high density areas including Gombak and Batu Caves and is an important gateway to Genting Highlands, Karak and the East coast of Malaysia.

The expressway features an advanced traffic information and management system, and is equipped with modern facilities such as variable messaging signs, central control and monitoring as well as electronic tolling.
