## **Penang Sentral Temporary Terminal Bus** and Taxi Services Moving to New Location

**Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 9 January 2014 –** Penang Sentral Sdn Bhd, (PSSB) wishes to inform that the bus and taxi operations at the Temporary Transport Terminal Penang Sentral (TTTPS) will be relocated to a site adjacent to the current terminal catering for users of the various bus and taxi operators.

The final day of bus and taxi operations at the current terminal at TTTPS will end at midnight on 12 January 2015, after which the operators will be shifting to the new temporary site in order to immediately commence their services on 13 January 2015.

All basic amenities similar to the current terminal will be provided for users' convenience. The new temporary location will include a total of 28 bus platforms and 33 ticket counters together with a taxi stand, a *surau*, an information counter and toilets. The bus platforms are covered with benches provided for waiting passengers.

Members of the public, especially regular users of these services, are advised to observe the signs posted in order to access the new location with ease.

Those using vehicles via the Butterworth Outer Ring Road are advised to use Exit 1703 to get to the bus terminal located about 30 meters after the exit, while the taxi stand can be accessed by immediately turning into Jalan Pantai after coming out of Exit 1703.

The new temporary bus and taxi terminal will also be easily accessible to ferry and train passengers via the current covered walkway to the KTMB Butterworth Station as it is located next to the train station. The same walkway can also be used by bus passengers who want to access the ferry terminal and train station.
